Riverside County Office of Foreign Trade has elected Ms. Kusum Kavia, Executive Vice President of Corona-based Combustion Associates, Inc. The next meeting will take place Feb. 1. The officers and board members will review the bylaws, and as soon as they have been reviewed by a participating law firm, the bylaws will be made public. The organization will be run by its officers, board and member manufacturers. The County of Riverside will provide staff support and office space as needed as the association grows.

*CAI is a manufacturer and EPC for modular power plants and process system skids. CAI is currently in the commissioning phase of an 80 MW “Green Field” Power Plant in West Africa. Other exports include the countries of Belize, Jordan and Kazakhstan.*
